_Art Adventures: May 30 – June 3 \$85.00: This week will introduce day campers to art and multiple media. Campers will express their creativity as a vehicle to understanding God and His creation using a variety of medium. Camp activities include horseback riding on Monday, May 30th.

_Creation Commotion: June 6 – 10 \$70.00: This week will encourage day campers to discover God's creation in nature. They will use natural ingredients to create crafts that express their creative abilities and remind them of God's creative love.

_Tinker Time: June 13 – 17 \$85.00: Using gadgets such as clocks, tools, old-time motion toys campers will discover how things are assembled and how God's perfect laws of physics enable the things around us to work. Campers will create something new out of something old and learn how God makes us new in Christ. Camp activities include horseback riding on Monday, June 13th.

_Major Mission: June 20 – 24 \$70.00: Day campers will learn why we help others and participate in group service projects. Mission projects will include making items they will share with local ministries such as CHARM and the Baptist Center.

_Music Madness: June 27 – July 01 \$70.00: This week will introduce day campers to music and musical instruments. The kids will learn to make a joyful noise unto our loving God. They will make some simple backyard instruments and learn how to play them.

_Operation Outdoors: July 5 – 8 (Tuesday – Friday) \$70.00: Campers will participate in healthy life-style activities such as rock climbing, archery, fishing, and hiking. Through these activities we will discover how the way we were made is a reflection of God's love.

_History Hookup: July 11 – 15 \$85.00: This week is new this year! We hope to wake up our history by sharing stories and activities that reveal our Christian heritage from the earliest days of man all the way through recent times. Giving kids an opportunity to experience what it was like to live in different times, we hope to build an interest in how the past affects our futures. Camp activities include horseback riding on Monday, July 11th.

_Sports Spectacular: July 18 – 22 \$70.00: This week is about athletic sports. Campers will participate in the Camp Tipton *Mini-Olympics*. Campers will learn about teamwork and personal growth and use these experiences to develop sportsmanship and honor.

_Survival Splash: July 25 – 29 \$70.00: This week will introduce day campers to basic survival skills including making solar stills, campfire safety, building a fire with a bow drill, and crafting a simple lean-to. We will also discover spiritual survival skills for life.
